Food Safety is one of the brand promises from SIR FRUIT, which is taken extremely seriously. SIR FRUIT was made aware of possible Patulin, a naturally occurring mycotoxin, contaminated batches from a local supplier. After liaising with the supplier and through chemical analysis it was confirmed that only three product lines of the portfolio were affected by contaminated apple juice concentrate.

The following products have been recalled due to the current industry Patulin problem:

1. Green Machine (500ml and 1.5LT) product is sold nationally at retail stores (Shoprite Checkers, Spar, Dischem, PnP, Food Lovers Market etc).

Whilst the Patulin levels in this product is below the acceptance threshold, it is being withdrawn as a precautionary measure.
